This is an application for directing the respondents to release the outstanding dues/claims of the petitioner-hospitals.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners-applicants

seeks withdrawal of the present application.

Disposed of as withdrawn.

MAIN CASE

The petitioners, who are hospitals/medical institutions registered under the Ayushman Bharat Scheme, have *inter alia* approached this Court for seeking release of their pending dues.

Learned counsel for the petitioners refers to paragraph No.14 of the reply filed on behalf of the State-Health Agency, which is extracted as under:

"14. That the Empanelled Hospitals are admitting the Patients under the aforesaid scheme and duly raising the claims of the medical expenses with the State Health Agency (SHA) i.e., Respondent no.2. That as per the record available with the State Health Agency (SHA) of the petitioners

It is pertinent to mention here that the majority of petitioners' Hospitals are working under the trust mode and duly raising medical claims with the State Health Agency (SHA). It is further submitted that for the time period **30 December 2021 to 18 December, 2022 (date of filing writ petition)** majority hefty claims amounting to **Rs. Twenty-six crore ten lakh ninety-five thousand three hundred and thirty-one (Rs. 261,095,331)** has been paid to the petitioner hospitals and the pending claim amount is under active consideration and will be released after claim adjudication of the same."

It is contended that notwithstanding the bills to tune of more than Rs.500 crores pending with the respondents and the liability having been acknowledged by them in the above quoted paragraph, only an amount of Rs.26 crores approximately has been released.

Learned Addl. Solicitor General of India contends that as per the Ayushman Bharat Scheme, 60% of the medical bills are to be reimbursed by the Union of India and that an amount of Rs.355.48 crores upto financial year 2023-24 has already been released by the Union of India to the State Government and that the obligation to disburse the same is on the State Health Agencies including their own component of the dues to the extent of 40%. He contends that the State has not only not released its own share but has also misutilized the share already released by the Union of India.

The State Government has chosen to adopt the reply filed by the State Health Agency. It is thus established from a perusal of the reply and by the respondents themselves acknowledging the liability of more than Rs.500 crores upto 18.12.2022, they have, however, failed to offer any explanation as to why the undisputed payment in question has not been released in favour of the petitioners-hospitals.

What is surprising is that even though a sum of more than Rs.350 crores has been claimed to be released by the Union of India, however, even the said amount, which has been received by State of Punjab/State Health Agency from Union of India, has not been disbursed and they have unlawfully retained the amount.

Counsel for the respondents-State as well as State Health Agency contend that after the filing of instant reply, they have made further release of payments in favour of the petitioners, however, they have no information in this regard. Such an oral assertion made without any instructions on record does not inspire any confidence and still needs to be verified.

Let an affidavit be filed by the State Government of Punjab giving the details of the payments that have been made against bills since 30.12.2021 to 24.09.2024 alongwith the date on which such payment was released, within a period of two weeks from today.

The salaries of Kumar Rahul, IAS, Principal Secretary, Department of Health, Ms. Babita, Chief Executive Officer, Mr. Deepak, Director and Ms. Sharanjit Kaur, Deputy Director, State Health Agency, Department of Health and Family Welfare, Punjab shall remain attached till the next date of hearing.

This Court also tentatively records that there is no satisfactory explanation put forth before this Court as to why despite the funds having been received from the Government of India, the payments have not been released in favour of the petitioners-hospitals and as to under what circumstances, the State Government could have withheld the said amount once it had been received from the Government of India against verified bills and for further remittance to the empanelled hospitals. Ordinarily any such action would have called for stern orders against the erring officials who misdirected the funds and diverted the same for unauthorized use, however, before proposing any action, it is deemed expedient to seek a detailed response from the State about the financial reimbursement received by the State of Punjab from the Union of India from December 2021 uptill now and how that money has been utilized. The affidavit shall also inform whether the amount received from Union of India towards Ayushmaan Bharat Payments could be used for the said purposes (for which the amount has been utilized) or not. Let the aforesaid affidavit be filed by the Principal Secretary, Heath and Family Welfare or the Chief Executive Officer of the State Health Agency for and on behalf of the State.

Additionally, the Principal Secretary, Finance is directed to file an affidavit giving expenses incurred by the State under the following heads during the same period i.e. December 2021 till September 2024:

- The expenses incurred for publishing advertisement in print and audiovideo media including break-up about the States and languages where such advertisements have been published/played.
- (ii) The expenses incurred on renovation of the houses/offices of Class-I officers as well as Ministers/MLAs in Punjab.
- (iii) Expenses incurred in purchase of new vehicles alongwith their make for the Ministers/MLAs and Class-I officers in the State of Punjab.
- (iv) The litigation expenses paid for pursuing matters before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India or Delhi High Court in defending/pursuing matters for the State of Punjab or for any other person or agency and instrumentality of State of Punjab or outside.

 (v) The expenditure incurred in various social welfare schemes such as free electricity, Atta Dal Scheme etc. as against the budgetary allocation for the same period.

The aforesaid information is being sought currently for examining as to whether the funds/grants received for any specific purpose are being misapplied or misutilized or not. The State, having received money for any specified purpose, is a custodian of said money only to release it to the actual beneficiaries and certainly cannot be permitted to retain the amount leaving the citizens litigating for their dues and misappropriate the said grants at the costs of the actual recipient.
